22 AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 3, lines 9 and 10, delete all new language

24 "diagnostic examination for breast cancer"

1 AMENDMENT NO. 5. Page 3, line 22 1/2, insert a new subsection D to
2 read as follows:

3 "D. If application of this act would result in health savings
4 account ineligibility under Section 223 of the Federal Internal
5 Revenue Code, as amended, the provisions of this section shall only
6 apply to health savings accounts with qualified high deductible
7 health plans with respect to the deductible of such a plan after the
8 enrollee has satisfied the minimum deductible. Provided, however,
9 the provisions of this section shall apply to items or services that
10 are preventive care pursuant to Section 223 (c) (2) (c) of the
11 Federal Internal Revenue Code, as amended, regardless of whether the
12 minimum deductible has been satisfied."

15 AMENDMENT NO. 6. Page 1, restore the amended title and the enacting
16 clause

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 36 O.S. 2021, Section 6060, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 6060. A. For the purposes of this section, 7:

17 1. "Breast magnetic resonance imaging" means a diagnostic tool
18 used to produce detailed pictures of the structure of the breast;

19 2. "Breast ultrasound" means a noninvasive, diagnostic imaging
20 technique that uses high-frequency sound waves to produce detailed
21 images of the breast;

22 3. "Diagnostic examination for breast cancer" means a medically
23 necessary and appropriate examination, as determined by a clinician
24

1 who is evaluating the individual for breast cancer, to evaluate the
2 abnormality in the breast that is:

- 3 a. seen or suspected from a screening examination for
4 breast cancer,
- 5 b. detected by another means of examination, or
- 6 c. suspected based on the medical history of family
7 medical history of the individual.

8 This examination may include, but is not limited to, a
9 diagnostic mammogram, breast magnetic resonance imaging, or a breast
10 ultrasound;

11 4. "Diagnostic mammography" means a diagnostic tool that:

- 12 a. uses X-ray, and
- 13 b. is designed to evaluate abnormality in a breast;

14 5. "Health benefit plan" means any plan or arrangement as
15 defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of this title;

16 ~~2.~~ 6. "Low-dose mammography" means:

- 17 a. the X-ray examination of the breast using equipment
18 specifically dedicated for such purpose, with an
19 average radiation exposure delivery of less than one
20 rad mid-breast and with two views for each breast,
- 21 b. digital mammography, or
- 22 c. breast tomosynthesis;

23 ~~3.~~ 7. "Breast tomosynthesis" means a radiologic mammography
24 procedure involving the acquisition of projection images over a

1 stationary breast to produce cross-sectional digital three-
2 dimensional images of the breast from which breast cancer screening
3 diagnoses may be made; and

4 8. "Screening mammography" means a radiologic procedure
5 provided to a woman, who has no signs or symptoms of breast cancer,
6 for the purpose of early detection of breast cancer, including
7 breast tomosynthesis.

8 B. All health benefit plans shall include the coverage
9 specified by this section for a low-dose mammography screening and a
10 diagnostic examination for the presence of occult breast cancer.

11 Such coverage shall not:

12 1. Be subject to the policy deductible, co-payments and co-
13 insurance limits of the plan; or

14 2. Require that a female undergo a mammography screening at a
15 specified time as a condition of payment.

16 C. 1. Any female thirty-five (35) through thirty-nine (39)
17 years of age shall be entitled pursuant to the provisions of this
18 section to coverage for a low-dose mammography screening once every
19 five (5) years.

20 2. Any female forty (40) years of age or older shall be
21 entitled pursuant to the provisions of this section to coverage for
22 an annual low-dose mammography screening.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
