21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 36 O.S. 2021, Section 6060, is
22 amended to read as follows:

23 Section 6060. A. For the purposes of this section~~7~~:

24 1. "Breast magnetic resonance imaging" means a diagnostic tool
used to produce detailed pictures of the structure of the breast;

2. "Breast ultrasound" means a noninvasive, diagnostic imaging
technique that uses high-frequency sound waves to produce detailed
images of the breast;

1 3. "Diagnostic examination for breast cancer" means a medically
2 necessary and clinically appropriate examination, as defined by
3 current guidelines and as determined by a clinician who is
4 evaluating the individual for breast cancer, to evaluate the
5 abnormality in the breast that is:

- 6 a. seen or suspected from a screening examination for
7 breast cancer,
8 b. detected by another means of examination, or
9 c. suspected based on the medical history of family
10 medical history of the individual.

11 This examination may include, but is not limited to, a
12 diagnostic mammogram, breast magnetic resonance imaging, or a breast
13 ultrasound;

14 4. "Diagnostic mammography" means a diagnostic tool that:

- 15 a. uses X-ray, and
16 b. is designed to evaluate abnormality in a breast;

17 5. "Health benefit plan" means any plan or arrangement as
18 defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of this title;

19 ~~2.~~ 6. "Low-dose mammography" means:

- 20 a. the X-ray examination of the breast using equipment
21 specifically dedicated for such purpose, with an
22 average radiation exposure delivery of less than one
23 rad mid-breast and with two views for each breast,
24 b. digital mammography, or

1 c. breast tomosynthesis;

2 ~~3.~~ 7. "Breast tomosynthesis" means a radiologic mammography
3 procedure involving the acquisition of projection images over a
4 stationary breast to produce cross-sectional digital three-
5 dimensional images of the breast from which breast cancer screening
6 diagnoses may be made; and

7 8. "Screening mammography" means a radiologic procedure
8 provided to a woman, who has no signs or symptoms of breast cancer,
9 for the purpose of early detection of breast cancer, including
10 breast tomosynthesis.

11 B. All health benefit plans shall include the coverage
12 specified by this section for a low-dose mammography screening for
13 the presence of occult breast cancer and a diagnostic examination
14 for breast cancer. Such coverage shall not:

15 1. Be subject to the policy deductible, co-payments and co-
16 insurance limits of the plan; or

17 2. Require that a female undergo a mammography screening at a
18 specified time as a condition of payment.

19 C. 1. Any female thirty-five (35) through thirty-nine (39)
20 years of age shall be entitled pursuant to the provisions of this
21 section to coverage for a low-dose mammography screening once every
22 five (5) years.

1 2. Any female forty (40) years of age or older shall be
2 entitled pursuant to the provisions of this section to coverage for
3 an annual low-dose mammography screening.

4 D. If application of this act would result in health savings
5 account ineligibility under Section 223 of the Federal Internal
6 Revenue Code, as amended, the provisions of this section shall only
7 apply to health savings accounts with qualified high deductible
8 health plans with respect to the deductible of such a plan after the
9 enrollee has satisfied the minimum deductible. Provided, however,
10 the provisions of this section shall apply to items or services that
11 are preventive care pursuant to Section 223(c)(2)(c) of the Federal
12 Internal Revenue Code, as amended, regardless of whether the minimum
13 deductible has been satisfied.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
