6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to property; limiting total land
8 allowed to be owned by the state and federal
9 government; limiting easements held by the federal
10 government to a certain time period; limiting
11 easement held by the state to a certain time period;
12 providing for codification; and providing an
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1110 of Title 60, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The state shall limit the amount of public land owned by the
19 State of Oklahoma, state agencies, and federal government to no more
20 than ten percent (10%) of the total land in the state.

21 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1110 of Title 60, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 A. All easements granted to or reserved by the federal
government, on or after the effective date of this act, for land

1 located in the state of Oklahoma shall be for a period of thirty
2 (30) years or less.

3 B. All easements granted to or reserved by the State of
4 Oklahoma or state agencies shall be for a period of thirty (30)
5 years or less. Any easements held by the State of Oklahoma or any
6 state agency that has been owned by the state or any state agency
7 for longer than thirty (30) years are hereby released and
8 relinquished.

9 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
