**Research Analysis**

Committee Amendment 1 restores stricken language in Paragraph G of Section 3 of the bill (Title 59, Section 396.12f) which exempts records on complaints against any licensee of the Funeral Services Board from the Open Records Act, unless the board gives written notice.

The amendment further deletes the new language added to Paragraph G relating to confidentiality of complaint information.
