Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 3196 creates the Burt Holmes Fee Structure Policy Act of 2022. The measure modifies the structure of fees collected by the courts for various offenses.

Fiscal Analysis

The first proposed committee substitute to the measure would create the Burt Holmes Fee Structure Policy Act of 2022.

The substitute would modify the structure of fees collected by the courts on various offenses for certain executive branch agencies. A total of 20 distinct fees are amended.

Upon review and with consultation from the Administrative Office of the Courts, passage of the measure would have a negative revenue impact of approximately \$9.1 million dollars for a full fiscal year. This figure is based on total collections for these fees for FY-2020.

Other Considerations

The substitute has an effective date of January 1st, 2023. The impact for FY-2023 would then be approximately half the total for a full fiscal year, or approximately \$4.6 million.
