Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB3205 repeals [Section 2-2-509 of Title 10A](#) of the Oklahoma Statutes, which allows a court to assess court costs, treatment costs, drug-testing costs, supervision and program fees against juvenile offenders and their legal guardians.

The measure also eliminates numerous provisions within the Oklahoma Juvenile Code that address the following costs, fines and fees. Currently, some of these costs are mandatory and some are discretionary and may be waived based on the ability of the child or guardian to pay.

- costs of medical treatment ordered by the court for a child in custody;
- costs associated with legal representation for a youthful offender by a court appointed county indigent defender;
- \$25 per month probation/supervision;
- fines ordered by the court to be paid by the child into the special Work Restitution Fund; and
- \$25 to \$500 fee paid to the Office of Juvenile Affairs for a presentence investigation.
