Research Analysis

HB 3504 adds definitions to the bill. The measure specifies insurance coverage for a diagnostic examination of occult breast cancer.

The Senate amendments to HB 3504 updates statutory language and adds Section 1, subsection D regarding health savings accounts. The SAHB 3504 adds the following Coauthors to the measure:

Fiscal Analysis

Upon consultation with the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, the measure's estimated annual fiscal impact would be a \$1.3 million increase to the plan's overall cost, which is less than a .25 percent increase in the total premium. This estimate is based on the member cost share for claims related to mammograms, breast MRIs, and breast ultrasounds under the HealthChoice 2021 plan year experience and considered historical experience from 2020 and 2019. The impact beyond one year would be expected to increase with consistent medical trends.
