**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB3543 creates the Free Speech Committee within the Oklahoma State Regents. The Committee Shall:

- Review the free speech policies of state universities;
- Create a process for accepting free speech complaints, and review the complaints;
- Review university training on free speech;
- Develop a First Amendment training that shall be required for all college deans, heads of departments, and individuals responsible for creating free speech policies and handling related complaints;
- Prepare a free speech survey and administer it to all faculty, staff, and students of Oklahoma's universities every four years.
