HB4107 requires the State Board of Education to issue a teaching certificate to a person who holds a teaching certificate from a federally recognized tribal nation. The certificate is only applicable for a school that is operated by the certificate-granting tribal nation. The person is exempt from all competency exams except those required by the tribal nation. The person must complete a criminal history background check.
