**Research Analysis**

PCS1 to HB 4327 prohibits a physician from knowingly performing or inducing an abortion on a pregnant woman unless such abortion is performed to save the life of the mother. PCS1 specifies that the act will be enforced exclusively through private civil actions with certain requirements. The bill specifies damages if a claimant prevails in an action brought under this act. PCS1 also prohibits a court to award relief under this bill where the abortion in question was performed to save the life of the mother. The measure specifies defenses and non-defenses to actions brought under the act. HB 4327 prohibits the state, a state official, or a district from intervening in an action brought under this bill.
