Research Analysis

SB 918 requires the act to become effective on and after the certification of the Attorney General that the U.S. Supreme Court overrules the central holding of *Roe vs. Wade*, 410 U.S. 113 (1973), thereby restoring to the State of Oklahoma the authority to prohibit abortion or if an amendment to the U.S. constitution is adopted and the authority to prohibit abortion in the State of Oklahoma is restored.

The measure repeals 21 O.S. 2011, Sections 684, 714, 862 and 863 which relate to crimes and punishment.
