**Bill Analysis**

SB 1113 directs the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to provide competency restoration services in county jails to persons determined not to be fit for trial if a forensic bed has not become available within 30 days after the court made such a determination. Additionally, if a person receives restoration services at the forensic facility, the attending physician of the forensic facility is authorized to treat the person as the physician deems necessary without the consent of the person, including the use of medication.
