HOUSE BILL 1001

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to health insurance; defining terms; specifying insurance policies under certain circumstances; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8000 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. As used in this act:

1. "Fertilization" means the fusion of a human spermatozoon with a human ovum.

B. All insurers in this state shall recognize fertilization as a qualifying life event, and shall be required to allow for open enrollment into their policies to update that individual's insurance coverage.

1 C. Any insurance provider not complying with this act shall be
2 prohibited from being assigned any state or local contracts for
3 insurance uses.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
