1 <u>Technology Education for teaching students between sixteen (16) and</u> 2 nineteen (19) years of age.

B. The tuition and/or or fees for attending the Basic Peace
Officer Certification Academies and/or or other law enforcement
related training will be at a rate established by CLEET and approved
by the Council. Tuition and/or or fees charged under this section
will shall be deposited in the Peace Officer Revolving Fund
established in Section 3311.7 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statues
this title.

10 С. Individuals not commissioned or appointed by a law 11 enforcement agency who are trained in the Basic Peace Officer 12 Certification Academies will shall be required to meet minimum 13 requirements established for peace officers as set forth in Section 14 3311 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title. Any fees 15 relating to meeting these requirements shall be the responsibility 16 of the individual. Individuals applying for the Academies will 17 shall be required to submit a fingerprint check to CLEET prior to 18 acceptance.

D. The Council is authorized to promulgate emergency rules to
effectuate the provisions of this subsection section.

E. Upon successful completion of the Basic Peace Officer
 Certification Academy, the individual's CLEET certification will of
 the individual shall become effective upon employment by an Oklahoma
 law enforcement agency. Employment and certification must be
