6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health; prohibiting
8 vaccination as a condition of public or private
9 employment; preempting certain rules and ordinances;
10 providing for codification; and providing an
11 effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-506.1 of Title 63, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. No person shall be required to receive any vaccine as a
17 condition of his or her public or private employment.

18 B. The State Legislature hereby preempts any employment-related
19 vaccination mandate enacted by any agency, board, or commission with
20 rulemaking authority or by any ordinance enacted by any political
21 subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, counties,
22 cities, towns, and municipalities.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
