13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 3A O.S. 2011, Section 604.1, as
14	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 461, O.S.L. 2019 (3A O.S. Supp.
15	2020, Section 604.1), is amended to read as follows:
16	Section 604.1. A. There is hereby re-created, until July 1,
17	$\frac{2021}{2024}$, in accordance with the Oklahoma Sunset Law, the Oklahoma
18	State Athletic Commission, which shall be composed of nine (9)
19	members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the
20	Senate. The member of the Commission initially appointed pursuant
21	to this act shall serve a term of three (3) years that shall expire
22	on June 30, 2006. Members appointed to the Commission shall serve
23	for terms of three (3) years. Terms of office shall expire on June
24	30. All vacancies and unexpired terms shall be filled in the same

1 manner as the original appointment and within sixty (60) days from 2 the date of the vacancy. Members may be removed by the Governor for 3 incompetence, willful neglect of duty, corruption in office, or 4 malfeasance in office.

5 B. Members appointed to the Commission shall reside in this6 state and shall have the following qualifications:

7 1. Two members shall have experience as a professional
8 combative sports practitioner, other than as a professional wrestler
9 or in professional combative sports promotions;

One member shall have experience as a professional wrestler
 or in professional wrestling promotions;

One member shall have experience in sports medicine;
 One member shall have experience in the cable television
 business; and

15 5. Four members shall represent the public at large as lay16 members.

17 C. No member of the Commission or any person related to a 18 member within the third degree by consanguinity or affinity shall 19 promote, sponsor, or have any financial interest in the promotion or 20 sponsorship of any professional combative sports event or amateur 21 mixed martial arts event while a member of the Commission.

D. The members of the Commission shall elect from their membership a chair and vice-chair to serve for one-year terms. A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of

1 conducting the business of the Commission. The Commission shall
2 meet at least quarterly, and special meetings may be called by the
3 chair.

E. The Commission shall comply with the provisions of the
Oklahoma Open Meeting Act, the Oklahoma Open Records Act, and the
Administrative Procedures Act.

F. All members of the Commission and such employees as
determined by the Commission shall be bonded as required by Sections
85.26 <u>85.580</u> through 85.31 <u>85.58V</u> of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
Statutes.

11 G. Members of the Commission shall serve without compensation 12 but shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the performance of 13 their duties as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
