HOUSE BILL 1890

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to agriculture; amending 2 O.S. 2011, Section 7-414, which relates to the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act; allowing for certain incidental sales of raw milk by delivery; requiring certain label; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 7-414, is amended to read as follows:

Section 7-414. A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act shall not be construed to:

1. Include incidental sales of raw milk directly to consumers at the farm where the milk is produced;

2. Include incidental sales of raw milk delivered by the farm producer directly to the final consumer's residence from the farm where the milk is produced; provided any raw milk shall be clearly labeled by the producer as "unpasteurized raw milk";

3. Preclude the advertising of the incidental sale of goat milk; and

1 ~~3.~~ 4. Prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using
2 milk or cream produced on the farm of such farmer or producer.

3 B. For purposes of this section, incidental sales of goat milk
4 are those sales where the average monthly number of gallons sold
5 does not exceed one hundred (100).

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
