16	Products Act shall not be construed to:
17	1. Include incidental sales of raw milk directly to consumers
18	at the farm where the milk is produced;
19	2. <u>Include incidental sales of raw milk delivered by the farm</u>
20	producer directly to the final consumer's residence from the farm
21	where the milk is produced; provided any raw milk shall be clearly
22	labeled by the producer as "unpasteurized raw milk";
23	3. Preclude the advertising of the incidental sale of goat

3. 4. Prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using milk or cream produced on the farm of such farmer or producer. B. For purposes of this section, incidental sales of goat milk are those sales where the average monthly number of gallons sold does not exceed one hundred (100). SECTION 2.
