13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2011, Section 2808, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 2808. A. As used in the Ad Valorem Tax Code:
17	1. "Public service corporation" means all transportation
18	companies, transmission companies, all gas, electric, light, heat
19	and power companies and all waterworks and water power companies,
20	and all persons authorized to exercise the right of eminent domain
21	or to use or occupy any right-of-way, street, alley, or public
22	highway, along, over or under the same in a manner not permitted to
23	the general public;

2. "Transportation company" means any company, corporation, 1 2 trustee, receiver, or any other person owning, leasing or operating for hire, a street railway, canal, steamboat line, and also any 3 4 sleeping car company, parlor car company and express company, and 5 any other company, trustee, or person in any way engaged in such business as a common carrier. As used in the Ad Valorem Tax Code, 6 7 the term "transportation company" shall not include any railroad or any air carrier. However, all railroad and air carrier property 8 9 shall continue to be valued and assessed by the State Board of 10 Equalization for purposes of ad valorem taxation;

3. "Transmission company" means any company, corporation,
 trustee, receiver, or other person owning, leasing or operating for
 hire any telegraph or telephone line or radio broadcasting system;

14 4. "Person" means individuals, partnerships, associations, and
 15 corporations in the singular as well as plural number;

16 5. "Video services provider" means a subclass of public service 17 corporations consisting of any public service corporation offering 18 video programming services; and

19 6. "Video programming" shall have the same meaning as set forth
 20 in 47 U.S.C., Section 522(20); and

21 7. "Fixed wireless broadband Internet service provider" means 22 an entity that offers access to the Internet through a stationary 23 fixed point-to-point connection often requiring direct line of sight

1 between the provider's wireless transmitter and its end-user
2 consumer's receiver.

B. As used in the Ad Valorem Tax Code, "transmission company"
and "public service corporation" shall not be construed to include
cable television companies or fixed wireless broadband Internet
service providers.

C. Any real or personal property used by any company, 7 8 corporation, trustee, receiver, or other person owning, leasing, or 9 operating for hire any pipeline or oil or gas gathering system which 10 was assessed by the State Board of Equalization after January 1, 11 1997, shall continue to be assessed by the State Board of 12 Equalization through ad valorem tax year 1998.
