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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 11-1110, as
15	amended by Section 1, Chapter 123, O.S.L. 2020 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020,
16	Section 11-1110), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 11-1110. A. No person shall throw or deposit upon any
18	highway any glass bottle, glass, nails, tacks, wire, cans or any
19	other substances likely to injure any person, animal or vehicle upon
20	such highway.
21	B. Any person who drops, or permits to be dropped or thrown,
22	upon any highway any destructive or injurious material shall
23	immediately remove the same or cause it to be removed.
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1 1. Any person removing a wrecked or damaged vehicle from a 2 highway, highway right-of-way or any other location as the result of an accident shall remove any glass or other injurious substance 3 dropped upon the highway or highway right-of-way or other location 4 5 from such vehicle. The owner or insurer of the owner of the vehicle if the owner's insurance policy provides coverage for such expense, 6 shall be responsible for the cost of removal of the vehicle and the 7 glass or other injurious substance and any vehicle storage fees. 8 9 The cost of the removal of the vehicle and any storage fees shall be 10 the same as established by the Corporation Commission for 11 nonconsensual tows.

12 2. Truck-tractors carrying cargo on the roadways of this state 13 shall maintain a general liability insurance policy that covers 14 <u>applies to</u> the costs of cleanup of any substance that is spilled or 15 otherwise deposited on the roadway or right-of-way in violation of 16 this section.

17 C. No person shall throw any substance at a standing vehicle or 18 any occupant thereof, nor shall any person throw any substance at a 19 person on or adjacent to a highway.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
