- 7. Punctuation errors the correction of which would not change the substantive provisions of the statute;
- 8. Citations in a statutory section to sections of an enacted measure that could be converted to a reference to the section or section and title of the Oklahoma Statutes without changing the substantive effect of the statute being revised;
- 9. Merging of multiple versions of a statute resulting from enactments that amend the same section of law during a regular or extraordinary session of the Legislature into a single version of the statute if the incorporation of amendments from the multiple versions can be achieved without creating a legal or logical conflict in the final version of the section; and
