18	At least four media timeouts of at least two (2) minutes each
19	shall be required at high school sporting events which are being
20	broadcast for television or radio. The media timeouts shall be from
21	the beginning to the end of each game and shall not include the
22	halftime break. All official or team timeouts shall be at least one
23	(1) minute to allow adequate time for media breaks. Media timeouts
