AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to prisons and reformatories;
amending 57 O.S. 2011, Section 332.1B, as amended by
Section 2, Chapter 263, O.S.L. 2018 (57 O.S. Supp.
2020, Section 332.1B), which relates to membership
eligibility requirements for the Pardon and Parole
Board; modifying eligibility requirements for members
of the Board; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 332.1B, as
amended by Section 2, Chapter 263, O.S.L. 2018 (57 O.S. Supp. 2020,
Section 332.1B), is amended to read as follows:

Section 332.1B A. To be eligible for appointment as a Pardon
and Parole Board member, a person shall ~~possess~~:

1. Possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or
university;

2. Not be employed by, serving on the board of or have any
pecuniary or proprietary interest in any commercial or nonprofit
enterprise providing direct services to offenders currently in the

1 custody or under the supervision of the Department of Corrections;

3 3. Have at least five (5) years of experience in one or more of

1 B. At least two members of the Pardon and Parole Board shall
2 have five (5) years of training or experience in mental health
