HOUSE BILL 2975

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2021, Section 4-120, which relates to cancellation of registrations; adding reason for cancellation; providing for written notice; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 4-120, is amended to read as follows:

Section 4-120. A. The registration of any registered voter ~~may~~ shall be canceled only for one of the following reasons:

1. Written notice from the voter pursuant to Section 4-120.1 of this title; ~~death; conviction~~

2. Death;

3. Conviction of a felony; ~~judicial~~

4. Judicial determination of mental incapacitation under Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes; ~~registration~~

5. Registration in another county or state; ~~or failure~~

1 6. Failure to respond to a confirmation of address mailing and
2 failure to vote as prescribed in Section ~~21~~ 4-120.2 of this ~~act~~
3 title; or

4 7. The surrendering of the voter's Oklahoma driver license to
5 the Department of Public Safety upon being issued a driver license
6 in another state.

7 B. For purposes of this section, paragraphs 5 and 7 of
8 subsection A of this section shall constitute written notice.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
