20	B. Any hospital which denies a medical, religious or
21	philosophical exemption to a mandatory employee vaccination policy
22	regarding the COVID-19 pandemic and subsequently fires a health
23	professional for being in violation of said vaccination policy shall

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be fined by the Oklahoma Department of Labor for the monetary amount
