7	An Act relating to higher education; prohibiting state educational institutions from refusing to
8	provide certain student transcripts; banning conditional release of transcripts; proscribing

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3218.16 of Title 70, unless
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. A state educational institution within The Oklahoma State
19	System of Higher Education shall not:
20	1. Refuse to provide a transcript of a current or former
21	student on the grounds that the student owes a debt to the
22	institution;
23	2. Condition the provision of a transcript on the payment of a
24	debt, other than a fee charged to provide the transcript; or

1 3. Charge a higher fee for obtaining a transcript or provide 2 less favorable treatment of a transcript request because a current 3 or former student owes a debt to the institution. 4 B. As used in this section, "debt" means any money, obligation, 5 claim, or sum, due or owing, or alleged to be due or owing, from a 6 current or former student, but shall not include the fee, if any, 7 charged to all students for the actual costs of providing 8 transcripts. 9 C. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require the 10 institution to forgive or cancel a debt owed by a current or former 11 student to the institution. 12 SECTION 2.
