6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Personnel Act;  
8 modifying provisions related to overtime pay for  
9 employees of the Department of Corrections; requiring  
election; providing for codification; providing an  
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 528.9 of Title 57, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 If a correctional officer accrues overtime and the overtime is  
18 compensable, the Department of Corrections may make payment for the  
19 overtime compensation not later than the fifteenth day of the month  
20 if the correctional officer elects to receive the payment at that  
21 time. A correctional officer shall be required to make an election  
22 with regard to the timing of overtime payments which shall be  
23 binding for a period of six (6) months at which time the election  
24

1 may either be renewed or, if not renewed, overtime payments shall be  
2 made at the same time as other payments for wages.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
