 - B. The transportation funds allocated to the school district pursuant to Section 18-201.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall not be reduced or otherwise penalized if the school district awards transportation grants authorized in this section.
 - C. The State Department of Education shall promulgate rules for the transportation grants and develop procedures to account for expenditures as provided by this section, including requiring proof of attendance for students who are transported to and from school through transportation grant funds.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.
 - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
