6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2021,
8 Section 3-101, which relates to election dates;
9 requiring certain entities to provide written notice
10 to voters prior to election; and providing an
11 effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 3-101, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 3-101. A. No election required to be conducted by any
16 county election board shall be scheduled for a day other than
17 Tuesday.

18 B. Except as otherwise provided by law, no regular or special
19 election to fill an elective office shall be held by any county,
20 school district, technology center school district, municipality,
21 fire protection district or other political subdivision authorized
22 to call elections except as follows:

- 23 1. The second Tuesday of February in any year;
24 2. The first Tuesday of April in any year;

1 3. The date of any regularly scheduled statewide state or
2 federal election in an even-numbered year;

3 4. The second Tuesday of September in an odd-numbered year;

4 5. The second Tuesday of November in an odd-numbered year; and

5 6. The second Tuesday of June of an odd-numbered year for a
6 special election to fill a vacancy.

7 C. Except as otherwise provided by law or by Section 1 of this
8 act, no election for any purpose other than to fill an elective
9 office shall be held by any county, school district, technology
10 center school district, municipality, fire protection district or
11 other political subdivision authorized to call elections except on:

12 1. The second Tuesday of January, February, May, June, July,
13 August, September, October and November and the first Tuesday in
14 March and April in odd-numbered years; provided, a municipality with
15 a population in excess of two hundred fifty thousand (250,000)
16 persons, according to the most recent federal decennial census, may
17 also hold an election on the second Tuesday of December in odd-
18 numbered years; and

19 2. The second Tuesday of January and February, the first
20 Tuesday in March and April, the last Tuesday in June, the fourth
21 Tuesday in August, and the first Tuesday after the first Monday in
22 November of any even-numbered year.

23 D. In the event that a regular or special election date occurs
24 on an official state holiday, the election shall be scheduled for

1 the next following Tuesday. In the event that any day of a
2 candidate filing period occurs on a Saturday, Sunday or any official
3 state holiday, that day of the filing period shall be scheduled for
4 the next business day.

5 E. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or any provision
6 of a municipal charter, any municipality, school district,
7 technology center district, county, rural fire protection district,
8 or any other entity seeking to hold a regular or special election to
9 be conducted by a county election board on the same date as a
10 regular or special federal or state election, shall file the
11 resolution calling for the election with the county election board
12 secretary no later than seventy-five (75) days prior to the election
13 date. A candidate filing period of three (3) days, if so required
14 by the resolution, shall begin no later than ten (10) days following
15 the deadline to file the resolution with the secretary of the county
16 election board; provided, the filing period for such municipal
17 office may be scheduled on the same dates as the filing period for
18 state or federal office to be filled at such election.

19 F. Any school district, technology center district,
20 municipality, including any municipality governed by charter, rural
21 fire protection district or any other entity seeking to hold a
22 special election for the purpose of filling a vacancy shall schedule
23 a candidate filing period of three (3) days to begin not more than
24 twenty (20) days following the date the resolution calling the

1 election is required to be filed with the secretary of the county
2 election board.

3 G. Any entity calling an election pursuant to subsection C of
4 this section shall provide written notice to every registered voter
5 eligible to vote in the election informing the voter of the upcoming
6 election. The written notice shall contain:

- 7 1. The date of the election; and
8 2. The website address of the entity calling the election that
9 allows the voter to review the text of the proposed ballot.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
