HOUSE BILL 3188

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to free speech; prohibiting interference by the State of Oklahoma with online free speech; prohibiting interference with online free speech on the part of entities receiving funds from the State of Oklahoma; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2200 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The government of the State of Oklahoma shall not erode, censor, or block the free speech of any citizen of the State of Oklahoma on an online platform.

B. Any entity that receives funding from the State of Oklahoma that engages in the erosion, censorship, or blocking of free speech of any Oklahoman on an online platform shall lose access to those funds.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
