16	A. The government of the State of Oklahoma shall not erode,							
17	censor, or block the free speech of any citizen of the State of

19	B. Any entity that receives funding from the State of Oklahoma							
20	that engages in the erosion, censorship, or blocking of free speech							
21	of any Oklahoman on an online platform shall lose access to those
