14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 528.9 of Title 57, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. The Department of Corrections shall provide minimum
18	correctional officer staffing sufficient to ensure continuous
19	appropriate supervision of inmates at all facilities of the
20	Department according to the profile of each individual facility.
21	When establishing the correctional officer-to-inmate ratio, the
22	Department shall consider the following:
23	1. Level of security at each facility;
24	2. Classification of inmates housed at each facility;

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1 Layout and configuration of each facility; 2 Perimeter or physical security of each facility; 4. 3 The ability to effectively classify and separate categories 5. 4 of inmates at each facility; and 5 6. Any other considerations that would require additional 6 correctional officer staffing at each facility. 7 Beginning November 1, 2022, the Department shall be required В. 8 to have a minimum ratio of one (1) correctional officer for every 9 five (5) inmates for each facility. 10 C. The Department shall publish on the homepage of its Internet 11 website a report listing each ratio of correctional officers to 12 inmates for every facility of the Department. SECTION 2.
