21	1. Normal operating hours;
22	2. Special health services provided;
23	3. Chronic clinic population;
24	4. Contracted specialty care referral;

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        5. Medication encounters;
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        6. Service types;
        7. Specialty care;
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        8. Ancillary services; and
        9. Any other special considerations that could require
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    additional medical staffing.
