14	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. As used in this section:
16	1. "Personal services" means any service which puts a nursing
17	home resident in a vulnerable position. Personal services include,
18	but are not limited to, the following services:
19	a. administering certain medications,
20	b. bathing the resident,
21	c. changing dressings,
22	d. changing bedpans, and
23	e. dressing the resident; and

2. "Private setting" means a setting in which a resident would be placed in a vulnerable position, such as a private room or bathroom. B. When a resident is in a private setting in a nursing home or skilled nursing home receiving personal services, there must be at least two individuals in the room with the resident. C. Any nursing home or skilled nursing home which violates this act may face monetary penalties and a loss of state certification. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022. 58-2-10250 KN 01/19/22 1.3
