AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to anatomical gifts; prohibiting for-profit entities from engaging in certain acts; providing exception; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2210.2A of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A for-profit entity shall not engage, directly or indirectly, in the procurement, transfer, or distribution of any human eye, cornea, eye tissue, corneal tissue, or portions of the eye, except as these parts are used for products which are regulated as devices, drugs, biologics, or combination devices.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
