L5	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be

L7	A. On October 1, 2022, each certified classroom teacher

L9	one-time bonus of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00). As used in this
20	section, "classroom teacher" means a person employed by a school
21	district to provide academic instruction to an assigned group of
22	students, who holds a valid certificate issued by and in accordance

with the rules of the State Board of Education.

- B. A certified classroom teacher who qualifies for the bonus pursuant to this section, and who is employed by a public school district on less than a full-time basis, shall receive a pro-rated bonus based on the proportionate equivalency to full-time employment.
- C. The bonus shall not be included in the calculation of salary for purposes of meeting the district or statutory minimum salary schedule or for purposes of calculating Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma contributions or benefits.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.
 - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
