HOUSE BILL 3656

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; authorizing school district to offer law enforcement elective course to juniors and seniors; listing certain information to be included in course; permitting State Board of Education to coordinate with the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training; authorizing Board to promulgate rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.15 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A school district may offer to students in grades eleven and twelve an elective course in law enforcement.

B. The law enforcement elective course shall include, at a minimum:

1. A general introduction to law enforcement training;
2. Critical skills and entry requirements for law enforcement professionals; and

1 3. Career opportunities in law enforcement.

2 C. The State Board of Education may coordinate with the Council
3 on Law Enforcement Education and Training to develop instructional
4 materials and curricula for schools to use in the law enforcement
5 elective course. The Board may promulgate rules to implement the
6 provisions of this section.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
