6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2021,
8 Section 6-101.42, which relates to support employee
9 pay; providing for increase in compensation of
10 certain school support employees; prescribing amount
11 of increase; providing increase in compensation as
12 additional to certain other compensation and fringe
13 benefits; providing for pro rata computation;
14 providing an effective date; and declaring an
15 emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-101.42, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 6-101.42 A. For the 2022-23 school year, each school
20 district shall provide to every support employee with a salary of
21 less than Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00) per year, a three
22 percent (3%) wage increase over the base amount the employee earned
23 during the 2021-22 school year if the support employee is employed
24 by the same school district for the 2022-23 school year. The dollar
amount of salary increase required by this subsection shall be

1 prorated based upon the number of total hours of work performed by a
2 full-time-equivalent support employee.

3 B. For the 2018-19 school year, each school district shall
4 provide to every support employee a wage increase over the base
5 amount the employee earned during the 2017-18 school year if the
6 support employee is employed by the same school district for the
7 2018-19 school year in the amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty
8 Dollars (\$1,250.00). The dollar amount of salary increase
9 authorized by this subsection shall be prorated based upon the
10 number of total hours of work performed by a full-time-equivalent
11 support employee.

12 ~~B.~~ C. The ~~increase~~ increases prescribed by this section shall
13 be in addition to any other compensation, increase in compensation,
14 and fringe benefits provided by the district or state, or mandated
15 by law or collective bargaining agreement, unless the hours or
16 duties of the support employee are reduced proportionately.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

18 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
