6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to medical marijuana; exempting  
8 veterans from taxes on retail medical marijuana  
9 sales; authorizing Oklahoma Tax Commission to  
10 promulgate rules; providing for codification; and  
11 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 426.2 of Title 63, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. There is hereby specifically exempted from the tax levied by  
17 Section 426 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes sales of retail  
18 medical marijuana to persons who have been honorably discharged from  
19 active service in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United  
20 States or Oklahoma National Guard.

21 B. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall promulgate any rules  
22 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
