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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1200 of Title 60, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	All residential developers constructing private roads for
17	residential developments shall either:
18	1. Construct roads to the current applicable code or regulation
19	of the incorporated municipality that the development is located or
20	the county if the development is located in an unincorporated
21	location.
22	2. Construct roads to a lesser standard than the applicable
23	code or regulation for a public road, however, residential
24	developers and any subsequent sellers must disclose that fact to

1	prospective buyers. Furthermore, developers or subsequent sellers
2	must obtain surety bond insurance guaranteeing future road
3	maintenance or payment for future road maintenance if the road
4	requires maintenance due the sub-standard construction.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
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
