1 STATE OF OKLAHOMA 2 2nd Session of the 58th Legislature (2022) 3 HOUSE BILL 3868 By: Boatman 4 5 6 AS INTRODUCED 7 An Act relating to alcoholic beverages; creating the alcoholic beverage gift basket license; providing guidelines for alcoholic beverage gift basket sales 8 and deliveries; providing that alcoholic beverage 9 gift basket licensee is responsible for delivery employees; providing maximum amount of alcohol that 10 can be in the gift basket; requiring the alcoholic beverages to be purchased from a retail spirit 11 licensee holder; requiring the holder of an alcoholic beverage gift basket license to maintain records and 12 submit reports to the Oklahoma ABLE Commission; authorizing the Oklahoma ABLE Commission to 1.3 promulgate rules, regulations, forms and procedures necessary to implement and enforce this license; 14 amending 37a O.S. 2021, Section 2-101, which relates to alcoholic beverage licenses; providing cost for an 15 alcoholic beverage gift basket license; amending 37A O.S. 2021, Section 2-133, which relates to licensee 16 responsibility for violation of law; adding alcoholic beverage gift basket licensee; providing for 17 codification; and providing an effective date. 18 19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 20 SECTION 1. A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW 21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-162 of Title 37A, unless there 22 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 23 An alcoholic beverage gift basket license shall authorize Α. 24 the holder thereof to sell and deliver alcoholic beverages including

beer, wine, and spirits in sealed original containers to consumers
aged twenty-one (21) years and older as follows:

1. Only employees of the alcoholic beverage gift basket licensee, who are twenty-one (21) years old and older shall be permitted to make alcoholic beverage gift basket deliveries to consumers;

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- 2. Payment for alcoholic beverage gift basket delivery by the alcoholic beverage gift basket licensee may be made by cash, check, transportable credit/debit card processors or advance on-line payment methods; and
- 3. The alcoholic beverage gift basket licensee shall be responsible for his or her delivery employees as provided in Section 2-133 of Title 37A of the Oklahoma Statutes.
 - B. Alcoholic beverage gift baskets may not contain more than:
 - 1. One-hundred forty-four (144) ounces of beer;
- 2. Two thousand two hundred fifty (2,250) milliliters of wine;
 and
 - 3. One thousand five hundred (1,500) milliliters of liquor.
 - C. The alcoholic beverages contained in a gift basket shall be purchased from a retail spirit licensee holder.
- D. A holder of an alcoholic beverage gift basket license shall maintain records and submit reports as required by the ABLE Commission.

 3 of this section.
 - C. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection A of this section:

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- 1. The license fee for a mixed beverage or bottle club license for those service organizations or fraternal beneficiary societies which are exempt under Section 501(c)(19), (8) or (10) of the Internal Revenue Code shall be Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per year; and
- 2. The renewal fee for an airline/railroad/commercial passenger vessel beverage license held by a railroad described in 49 U.S.C., Section 24301, shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- D. An applicant may apply for and receive both an on-premises beer and wine license and a caterer license.
- E. All licenses, except as otherwise provided, shall be valid for one (1) year from date of issuance unless revoked or surrendered. Provided, all employee licenses shall be valid for two (2) years.
- F. The holder of a license, issued by the ABLE Commission, for a bottle club located in a county of this state where the sale of alcoholic beverages by the individual drink for on-premises consumption has been authorized, may exchange the bottle club license for a mixed beverage license or an on-premises beer and wine

1	license and operate the licensed premises as a mixed beverage	
2	establishment or an on-premises beer and wine establishment subject	
3	to the provisions of the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act.	
4	There shall be no additional fee for such exchange and the mixed	
5	beverage license or on-premises beer and wine license issued shall	
6	expire one (1) year from the date of issuance of the original bottle	
7	club license.	
8	G. In addition to the applicable licensing fee, the following	
9	surcharge shall be assessed annually on the following licenses:

18	H. Any license issued by the ABLE Commission under this title
19	may be relied upon by other licensees as a valid license, and no
20	other licensee shall have any obligation to independently determine
21	the validity of such license or be held liable solely as a
22	consequence of another licensee's failure to maintain a valid
23	license.

                       AMENDATORY 37A O.S. 2021, Section 2-133, is
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    amended to read as follows:
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        Section 2-133. Each licensee authorized to deliver alcoholic
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    beverage products to consumers in Section ± 2-161 of this act title
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    and each bottle club or mixed beverage, beer and wine, caterer,
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    public event, charitable event or, special event, or alcoholic
    beverage gift basket licensee shall be held responsible for
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    violation of any alcoholic beverage law or administrative rule of
    the ABLE Commission affecting his or her license privileges and for
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    any act or omission of his or her servant, agent, employee or
    representative in violation of any law, municipal ordinance or
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    administrative rule affecting his or her license privileges.
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        SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
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
