L7	1. "Advertiser" means a person, entity, or facility which
L8	accepts funds for advertising or promoting a product, service, or
L9	content in a medium operated by such person, entity or facility; and

21	but not limited to pornography, except where enforcement of such
22	federal or state law has been enjoined by a federal or state court.
23	B. Except as described in subsection C of this section, it
24	shall be deemed injurious to competition for an advertiser to

- inhibit the publication or distribution of any content on the medium operated by the advertiser when one desiring to distribute that content pays for the publication or distribution of that content at a rate equal or greater than the rate charged by that advertiser for the distribution of other content.
 - C. Notwithstanding subsection B of this section, no advertiser shall be required to publish or distribute any content which:
 - 1. Itself constitutes a crime;
 - 2. Would cause a reasonable person to presume that the content recommends the commission of a crime;
 - 3. Itself is defamatory pursuant to state law;
- 12 4. Itself constitutes an invasion of privacy pursuant to state
 13 law; or
- 5. Itself constitutes a violation of state or federal copyright, trademark, or other intellectual property laws.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
