6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to students; allowing virtual charter
8 school students to participate in certain
9 extracurricular activities at their resident schools;
10 providing for participation to be consistent with
11 certain standards and rules; prohibiting additional
12 requirements for virtual charter school students;
13 providing for certain fees and fee waivers for
14 virtual charter school students; providing for
15 codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-145.9 of Title 70, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Students enrolled full time in a statewide virtual charter
19 school sponsored by the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board shall
20 be eligible to compete for, and if selected, participate in any
21 extracurricular activities governed by a school athletic association
22 as defined in Section 27-102 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes
23 that are offered at the resident public school district the students
24 would otherwise attend.

1 B. Student participation as provided in subsection A of this
2 section shall be consistent with all standards and rules of the
3 school athletic association as applied to full-time students of the
4 resident public school, including academic progress and discipline.
5 A school district or resident public school shall not impose
6 additional requirements on a virtual charter school student that are
7 not imposed on full-time students of the resident public school.

8 C. Students enrolled full time in a statewide virtual charter
9 school shall pay the same fees as other students to participate in
10 extracurricular activities governed by a school athletic association
11 and shall be eligible for the same fee waivers for which other
12 students are eligible.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
