AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution designating November 2022 as Men's
Health Awareness Month.

WHEREAS, men are one hundred percent (100%) less likely than
women to pursue annual screening and preventive care; and

WHEREAS, nearly sixty percent (60%) of men do not regularly see
a doctor; and

WHEREAS, men die an average of five (5) years earlier than
women; and

WHEREAS, only seven percent (7%) of men report discussing their
health; and

WHEREAS, higher mortality rates for men result in negative
economic, social, and emotional consequences for their surviving
families; and

WHEREAS, lack of awareness of and adherence to medical
recommendations and protocols contributes to men's poor health
outcomes.
