16	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
17	the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of
18	Oklahoma by adding a new Section 64 to Article V thereof, to read as

20	Section 64. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
21	"Oklahoma Legislative Department Modernization Act".
