AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution designating March 23, 2021 as Oklahoma  
Agriculture Day; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, agriculture serves all Oklahomans and Americans by

living for our citizens and our presence in world trade markets; and

WHEREAS, it is important that all Oklahomans should understand  
the role that agriculture plays in their lives and well-being,  
whether they live in urban or rural areas.

3       THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives hereby proclaims  
4 Tuesday, March 23, 2021, as Oklahoma Agriculture Day.

5       THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives will join efforts  
6 with agricultural organizations throughout the State of Oklahoma to  
7 continue recognizing and supporting agriculture.
