6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution commending Oklahoma Licensed Child Care
8 Centers and Homes for their heroic actions during the
9 COVID-19 pandemic.

11 WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020 and 2021 has caused
12 widespread sickness, health problems and death in Oklahoma and
13 caused an immense disruption in the financial and business sectors
14 of Oklahoma and its families; and

15 WHEREAS, Oklahoma Licensed Child Care Centers and Homes have
16 remained open during this time pursuant to the request of Governor
17 Stitt and despite the closing of many other places of education and
18 childcare; and

19 WHEREAS, Oklahoma Child Care Centers and Homes bore the brunt of
20 the financial burden caused by the costs of complying with both
21 state regulations and federal standards mandated by the Centers for
22 Disease Control and Prevention with only a brief reprieve for
23 reimbursement during July, August and September of last year with
24 the infusion of some money from the federal CARES Act; and

1 WHEREAS, Oklahoma Licensed Child Care Centers and Homes continue
2 to abide by the recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control
3 and Prevention and have had to shut down classrooms or an entire
4 center or home while using the industry-approved standards for daily
5 and weekly disinfecting even at a huge cost to the centers and
6 homes; and

7 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Licensed Child Care Centers and Homes
8 industry continued to care for children subsidized through the
9 Department of Human Services based on attendance and for children
10 through private pay based on enrollment, even though many have been
11 forced to close permanently because of financial deficits; and

12 WHEREAS, the surviving Oklahoma Licensed Child Care Centers and
13 Homes are resolved to continue to stay open and operational to help
14 the Oklahoma economy rebound by allowing the workforce to return to
15 their jobs, secure in the knowledge that their precious children are
16 being cared for by an educated, dedicated and competent cadre of
17 child care workers.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
19 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

20 THAT these workers and the Oklahoma Licensed Child Care Centers
21 and Homes are to be commended for their dedication, financial
