Any entity that employs individuals who are required by the state or a political subdivision to have licensure or certification issued by a state agency;

Any hospital licensed by the State Department of Health; or
Any private entity.

6 A covered entity or agent of a covered entity shall not С. 7 require the receipt of any vaccine used to prevent infection by any 8 current or future variant of SARS-CoV-2 or the development of 9 Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) for any reason including but not 10 limited to as a condition of employment, professional licensure, 11 educational admittance, certification or degree, admittance to any 12 place of business or entertainment, or access to any mode of 13 transportation.

D. A covered entity or agent of a covered entity shall not discriminate against, punish, demote, or isolate any employee of the covered entity based on whether the employee has received a vaccine used to prevent infection by any current or future variant of SARS-CoV-2 or the development of COVID-19.

E. A covered entity or agent of a covered entity shall not be liable in a civil action claiming an injury from exposure or potential exposure to any current or future variant of SARS-CoV-2 or from the development of COVID-19 if the act or omission alleged to violate a duty of care of the covered entity or agent of the covered entity was in compliance with this section.
