SENATE BILL 1166

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to political prisoners; providing for the Prohibition on Political Prisoners in Oklahoma Act; providing definition; declaring certain transport unlawful; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 700 of Title 57, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Prohibition on Political Prisoners in Oklahoma Act".

B. As used in this section, "political prisoner" shall be defined as a citizen of the United States of America who has been arrested, charged or convicted of any crime, other than a felony, relating to the United States Capitol building on January 6, 2021.

C. It shall be unlawful for any agency, entity or agent of the federal government of the United States to transport any political prisoner through the boundaries of the State of Oklahoma via any

1 means, which shall include but not be limited to the use of any
2 roads, conveyances, highways, interstates, airspace or any other
3 points of transit.

4 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
