NEW LAW 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 700 of Title 57, unless there is 15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 Α. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Prohibition 17 on Political Prisoners in Oklahoma Act". 18 B. As used in this section, "political prisoner" shall be 19 defined as a citizen of the United States of America who has been 20 arrested, charged or convicted of any crime, other than a felony, 21 relating to the United States Capitol building on January 6, 2021. 22 C. It shall be unlawful for any agency, entity or agent of the 23 federal government of the United States to transport any political

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prisoner through the boundaries of the State of Oklahoma via any

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1	means, which shall include but not be limited to the use of any
2	roads, conveyances, highways, interstates, airspace or any other
3	points of transit.
4	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
